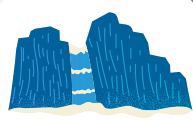
PURPOSE

- The aim of NatUR-W is to address urban challenges brought by a situation of energy poverty and climate change.
- NatUR-W seeks to develop, implement and validate the regeneration of urban areas by incorporating water management and self-sufficient NbS.
- Through NatUR-W, Lorca City Council is regenerating Barrios Altos, a neighbourhood in Lorca's historic centre.
